

BEHAVIOUR CODES

(a) Players

- Play by the rules of Netball
- Never argue with an official
- Not use verbal or physical abuse or behave in an unsportsmanlike manner to any player or official
- Work equally hard for the team as well as for themselves
- Play to enjoy the game as well as to improve their netball skills
- Be a good sport, applaud good play by both teams
- If any of the above are not abided by a player, then the coach has the right to refuse court time to that player

(b) Parents

- Parents are encourage the players to participate according to the rules of the game
- Respect official and teach their children to do likewise
- Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators
- Do not use foul language or harass players, coaches or officials
- Do not approach any coach during the game regarding their children.
- Approaches to the coach should be made after the game. If they still have a problem, then they should put it in writing to the President of the Club
- When their children are off the court, parents are to encourage and support them and encourage their children to support their team

PLAYERS RULES

If a player does not attend practice without prior notice to the coach, the coach has the right to minimize the player to one quarter of the game.

If a player continues to not attend practice, the coach has the right to reduce the court time.

If a player does not adhere to the rules, then the coach has the right to refuse court time to that player.

Players must notify the coach before the day of play if they are unable to attend.

If a player behaviours in a no appropriate manner during the game, then the coach has the right to remove them from the game.

The coach has the SOLE right over which player plays in any given position at any time.

During finals all players must have some court time, if they have observed the above rules. If a player has not adhered to the rules, the coach is bound to notify the player during practice prior to the game. This rule does not apply for teams in B grade or above.

REFUND POLICY

Any member who withdraws before grading day is eligible for a refund.

Any player who withdraws during grading is eligible for a refund less 10% for administrative costs

Any player who withdraws after teams have been announced is not eligible for a refund.

Any player withdrawing after registration at the Association is not eligible for a refund.

A player who withdraws due to exceptional circumstances may be eligible for a refund and the eligibility and amount is at the discretion of the Committee.

GRADING POLICY

Parents are not allowed to enter the court area while grading is taking place

Parents must not approach the Grading Committee at any time. Any queries can be directed to the convenor of the Grading Committee

If any parent is not satisfied with the response of the convenor, then they must put it in writing to the President of the Club

The convenor of each age group must report to the Management Committee before teams are announced

Players must accept the team they are placed in

From time to time junior players may be graded in a team of a different age group, if they demonstrate ability to play in a higher team or to form a mixed aged team.

Players joining after grading will be attached to the lowest team in that age group. If the lower team has an abundance of players, one (or more) player(s) (not necessarily the late joiner) may be placed in a higher team if that team requires extra players.
