REGISTERED LAST YEAR on SPORTING PULSE

Sporting Pulse is making it easier to access your SP products with a single email and password now referred to as your SP Passport. This gives you a single login for all SP products / sports. You may be prompted to create a new SP Passport, so click Register to create one and gain access to your SP Membership database. You will still need to use your username and password from season 2013 to register with Winthrop Netball Club.

FEES 2014

Our fees have remained the same for Junior and Senior players, but unfortunately we have had to significantly increase our Lower Primary fees and will do so over the next season as well, to come in line with Netball WA & FNA who now only have 2 groups of fees – Junior and Senior.

REFUNDS:

Refunds granted before grading commences are refunded in full less 10% (administration costs). However if a player withdraws during or after grading then no refund is payable except in exceptional circumstances. All applications for refunds must be submitted in writing to committee stating full reasons for withdrawal.

Winthrop Netball Club is a registered Kidsport club with the Department of Sport & Recreation. Kidsport is a financial aid program that supports parents and players with the payment of registration fees, equipment and uniforms to assist with the joining of sporting clubs. Kidsport is for those who have a Pension Card or a Health Care Card. The amount per applicant (eg child) is \$200 per year. Application forms need to be validated and approved by the local government authority (your local council) in which you live in **before** the application is given to Winthrop Netball Club.

GRADING/TRIALS

To ensure grading is conducted fairly and effectively, and in the best interests of the club and its players, all junior players must trial in their own age group based upon date of birth.

Players turning 8 years or older this season will commence trials on the following dates and times according to age / year of birth. Grading is an important process which helps establish the number and composition of the Winthrop Netball Club teams to compete in the Fremantle Netball Association (FNA) competition.
