REGISTRATION

Winthrop Netball Club has moved to online registration with Sporting Pulse for the 2013 season. The use of this system allows us to maintain accurate member records and ease of the registering of our teams with FNA as well as allowing our members to pay online using credit card and Eftpos facilities.

UMPIRING

Umpiring is a vital part of playing netball, without umpires there is no game. It is the policy of the Winthrop netball Club that all players from 14years and over are expected to develop their umpiring skills and umpire at some level. As a club we do our best to develop and encourage new umpires. Experienced and capable umpires are also in need for the club. We ask that you help your club by umpiring, whether it is on a regular basis or once or twice per round. ALL UMPIRES ARE PAID ACCORDING TO QUALIFICATION AND LEVEL OF GAME UMPIRED.

NEW UMPIRING POLICY FOR SENIORS - IMPORTANT

All 19U's to Senior players are required to supply and pay for their teams' allocated umpiring duties as described in the FNA fixtures. Players' will be assigned to games and a roster of the team's umpiring duties will be supplied to each team and the player allocated to a match has the choice of either umpiring themselves or arranging and organising payment for the umpire covering their allocated game. The fees have been adjusted to accommodate this change in procedure. The Umpiring Coordinator may be contacted for a list of available umpires via di.munt@bigpond.com.

Senior umpires can umpire additional games by contacting the Umpiring Coordinator and advising availability. Junior games will continue to be covered and paid for by the Club as will all finals. KIDSPORT

Winthrop Netball Club is a registered Kidsport club with the City of Melville and City of Canning. Kidsport is a financial aid program that supports parents and players with the payment of registration fees, equipment and uniforms to assist with the joining of sporting clubs. Kidsport is for those who have a Pension Card or a Health Care Card. The amount per applicant (eg child) is \$200 per year.

Application forms need to be validated and approved by the local government authority in which you live in **before** the application is given to Winthrop Netball Club.
